Motivation letter	The content of the letter, its structure and language are assessed.  The motivation letter is written in a free form. The volume of the motivation letter should be 1000 - 2000 characters. In the letter it is necessary to justify the choice of the program, to show the consciousness of the choice of specialization and scientific or practical interests related to the countries of the East. It should be clear from the letter to what extent the chosen specialization is related to the previous educational, academic or practical experience, as well as the expected further use of the acquired knowledge (for example, academic work, admission to graduate school, diplomatic, civil service, expert-analytical, pedagogical work, development of business and entrepreneurship, etc.) or why exactly it is necessary for the applicant and what will be the next step in the development of this direction.	10
Recommendations	For a recommendation, you should apply to a supervisor or a lecturer who has taught courses related to the content of the educational program for which you are applying. A specialist who knows the applicant from his/her research work can also can recommend. Recommendations from a specialized scientific institution are valued as much as possible. The recommendation is submitted in writing and is	5

	written in free form. The length of the recommendation should not usually exceed one page. The following items should be specified in the recommendation: - data of the recommender (full name, position, academic degree, place of work, phone number); - how long and by what activities (attending lectures, joint research, scientific supervision) the recommender knows the applicant; - assess the applicant's qualities: ability for scientific research, motivation to study, ability to work, ability to think independently, communication skills, etc.
