Motivation Letter	<p>The statement of interest should be written in English. It should indicate reasons for choosing this MA Programme; describe applicant’s possible MA research project; describe briefly what you plan to gain from MA teaching and, if possible, note whose work, research and specialisation from the staff of the teachers of the history department is the closest to you — who could be a potential scientific supervisor of your project. Writing sample of up to 50 pages	<p>The work does not have to correspond to the profile of this master's programme. Provide your most successful, in your opinion, published or unpublished text. This may be your BA thesis or its section, or another thesis, a publication or something prepared or intended for publication, or any unpublished manuscript.</p> <p>Writing sample evaluation criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– depth of analysis</li> <li>– use and analysis of sources</li> </ul>	0 - 15

The interview has to be appointed <b>in 14 days</b> after the day the application has been submitted upon condition that the application form is properly filled out and all required documents are submitted.</li> <li>2. Data and time for the interview are appointed by HSE St.Petersburg. By request of an applicant it is permitted to reschedule the time for interview once only. The applicant has to inform the Commission about rescheduling by sending an email to: <a href="mailto:iadmission-spb@hse.ru">iadmission-spb@hse.ru</a></li> <li>3. Skype with web-camera or similar available communication tool (Zoom) is used in order to conduct the interview. The interview might also be conducted internally.</li> <li>4.
