

**Admission Regulations
for Applicants to Bachelor's and Specialist Degree Programmes Offered by National
Research University Higher School of Economics (HSE) in 2018**

III. Special Aspects of International Admissions

3.1. Foreign citizens and/or stateless persons (hereafter, “foreign citizens”) may be admitted to HSE and its regional campuses:

3.1.1. on a state-funded basis (tuition waiver), and

3.1.2. on a fee-paying basis under agreements for paid educational services (hereinafter – “fee-paying basis”).

3.2. Foreign citizens may pursue degree programmes on a state-funded basis:

3.2.1. pursuant to international treaties of the Russian Federation, and federal laws;

3.2.2. pursuant to quotas established by the Government of the Russian Federation for education offered to foreign citizens and/or stateless persons (hereafter, the “admission quota for foreign citizens”).

3.3. Foreign citizens, who hold the status of compatriots living abroad, may enrol in HSE degree programmes on equal terms with Russian citizens, provided that they meet the requirements set forth in Article 17 of the Federal Law No. 99-FZ dated May 24, 1999 “On the State Policy of the Russian Federation Toward Compatriots Living Abroad” (hereafter, “Federal Law No. 99-FZ”).

3.4. Foreign citizens may be admitted to state-funded places, pursuant to subparagraph 3.2.1 and paragraph 3.3 hereof, and to fee-paying places in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Admission Regulations.

Foreign citizens may be admitted to studies in the framework of the admission quota, pursuant to subparagraph 3.2.2, on the basis of referrals issued by the federal executive body responsible for the state policy and statutory regulation of educational affairs (hereafter, the “referral for studies”), as per the procedure established at HSE.

Foreign citizens shall be admitted to studies within the admission quota on the basis of a separate enrolment directive(s).

3.5. Foreign citizens, who hold the status of compatriots living abroad but are not citizens of the Russian Federation, shall not be entitled to special rights which are granted to specific categories of Russian citizens, pursuant to Federal Law No. 273-FZ unless otherwise stipulated by international treaties of the Russian Federation.

3.6. In addition to the list of documents, specified in paragraph 2.14 of the Admissions Regulations, foreign citizens must submit the following documents along with their application:

- copies of documents and other evidence that the compatriot living abroad belongs to one of the groups stipulated in paragraph 6 of Article 17 of Federal Law No. 99-FZ, - for persons specified in paragraph 3.3 hereof;

- referral for studies – for persons specified in subparagraph 3.2.2 hereof;

- documents confirming that a foreign citizen meets the requirements stipulated by respective international treaties, – for applicants admitted on the basis of international treaties.

3.7. Applications for admission to HSE Bachelor's/Specialist programmes may be submitted in English or in Russian.

Documents prepared in a foreign language must be accompanied by a Russian translation, certified as per the established procedure. The applicant's last name, first name and middle name/patronymic (if any), stated in the translated versions of the submitted documents, should be the same as last name, first name and middle name/patronymic (if any) stated in the applicant's entry visa.

When submitting an educational document (degree certificate/diploma, etc.) issued by a foreign state, which must be accompanied by a certificate of recognition of foreign credentials, an applicant may initially present the afore-mentioned document without a certificate of recognition of foreign credentials, as long as the latter is submitted at a later date but no later than the deadline established for submission of student enrolment consents, pursuant to the procedures set forth in HSE bylaws.

When submitting an educational document issued by a foreign state that is subject to legalization and/or apostille procedures, an applicant may initially present the aforementioned document without legalization and/or an apostille, as long as this document is submitted with appropriate legalization and/or an apostille at a later date but no later than the deadline established for submission of student enrolment consents, pursuant to the procedures set forth in HSE bylaws.

3.8. Pursuant to subparagraph 3.2.1 and paragraph 3.3 hereof, foreign citizens shall be enrolled on the basis of results of entrance examination established by HSE and its regional campuses for specific categories of citizens, or on the basis of the USE (Unified State Examination) results.

Foreign citizens may choose to take all entrance examinations at HSE, or take one or more entrance examinations at HSE and have their USE results counted instead of exams for other subjects.

Entrance examinations for foreign citizens applying for admission to HSE, including HSE regional campuses in Nizhny Novgorod, Perm and Saint Petersburg (except for applicants to fee-paying places, pursuant to paragraph 3.10 hereof) are specified in Annexes 1, 2, 3, and 4 hereto, respectively.

3.9. Pursuant to subparagraph 3.2.1 and paragraph 3.1 hereof, foreign citizens shall be enrolled to state-funded places within the timeframe stipulated by paragraph 2.39 and 2.44 of these Admission Regulations.

3.10. HSE shall establish the number of fee-paying places available to foreign citizens under agreements for paid educational services at its own discretion and shall hold a special competition for applicants to these places.

3.11. Foreign citizens applying to fee-paying places under a special competition may submit respective documents in line with the requirements set by the Russian legislation and these Admission Regulations from November 15, 2017 to August 10, 2018. Applications shall be submitted to HSE and regional campuses as follows:

a) documents shall be submitted by applicants or their authorized representatives to the following addresses:

- for applications to HSE Moscow campus – International Admissions Office, Room 105, 13 Myasnitckaya Ulitsa, Bldg. 4, Moscow, Russia;
- for applications to HSE Nizhny Novgorod campus – 25/12 B. Pecherskaya Ulitsa, Nizhny Novgorod, Russia;
- for applications to HSE Perm campus – 38 Studencheskaya Ulitsa, Perm, Russia;
- for applications to HSE Saint Petersburg campus – 3 Kantemirovskaya Ulitsa, Korpus 1, Lit. A, St. Petersburg, Russia;

b) by public postal service – to the following addresses:

- for applications to HSE Nizhny Novgorod campus – Admissions Office, 25/12 B. Pecherskaya Ulitsa, Nizhny Novgorod, 603155, Russia, Nizhny Novgorod Regional Campus of National Research University Higher School of Economics;
- for applications to HSE Perm campus – Admissions Office, 38 Studencheskaya Ulitsa, Perm, 614070, Russia, Perm campus of National Research University Higher School of Economics;
- for applications to HSE St. Petersburg campus - Admissions Office, 3 Kantemirovskaya Ulitsa, Korpus 1, Lit. A, St. Petersburg, 194100, Russia, St. Petersburg campus of National Research University Higher School of Economics.

3.12. Foreign citizens, who apply to fee-paying places under a special competition, take two entrance examinations, pursuant to Annexes 10, 11, 12 and 13 hereto.

3.13. Entrance examinations held by HSE for foreign citizens applying to fee-paying places shall be completed by August 20, 2017. Entrance examinations shall be held in groups of applicants who submitted their applications via the Personal Account of a Foreign Applicant at <http://asav.hse.ru/foreignabit.html>.

3.14. Entrance examinations for admission to all HSE Bachelor's/Specialist programmes, stipulated in Annexes 10, 11, 12, and 13 hereto, except for the Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Double Degree Programme in Data Science and Business Analytics', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Double Degree Programme in Economics', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Parallel Degree Programme in Management and Digital Innovation', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and Kyung Hee University Double Degree Programme in Economics and Politics in Asia', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Parallel Degree Programme in International Relations, 41.03.05', International Business and Management Studies (HSE - St. Petersburg), Sociology and Social Informatics (HSE - St. Petersburg), Political Science and World Politics (HSE - St. Petersburg), shall be held in Russian.

Entrance examinations for admission to specific Bachelor's programmes, stipulated in Annexes 10, 11, 12, and 13 hereto, including the Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Double Degree Programme in Data Science and Business Analytics', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Double Degree Programme in Economics', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Parallel Degree Programme in Management and Digital Innovation', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and Kyung Hee University Double Degree Programme in Economics and Politics in Asia', Bachelor's programme 'HSE and University of London Parallel Degree Programme in International Relations, 41.03.05', International Business and Management Studies (HSE - St. Petersburg), Sociology and Social Informatics (HSE - St. Petersburg), Political Science and World Politics (HSE - St. Petersburg), shall be held in Russian or English, at the applicant's discretion.

3.15. Entrance examinations for foreign citizens, who apply for admission to fee-paying places under a separate competition, shall be held as a written test, except for additional entrance examinations with a focus on creative assignments. Applicants may request to have their USE results counted instead of examinations in relevant subjects.

Applicants may take more than one entrance examination per day if they wish.

3.16. Examinations, held by HSE pursuant to Annexes 10, 11, 12, and 13 hereto, can be taken using long-distance technologies, provided that the applicant's personal identification is guaranteed. The results of examinations held in long-distance mode shall be regarded on the same terms as the results of entrance examinations with personal attendance.

3.17. Paid educational services agreements shall be concluded with all foreign applicants by August 28, 2018.

The official enrolment of foreign citizens to fee-paying places shall be completed by August 31, 2018.
