## Criteria of portfolio for the program "International relations in Eurasia"

The criteria award points under the following headings with percentage weights in brackets:

- Academic merit (35%);
- Personal statement of motivation and research interests (35%);
- References (10%);
- English language (10%) and
- Other relevant experience/interests (10%).

You need to hold (or expect to obtain) an upper second class honours degree (or international equivalent) in a relevant subject area. If your Bachelors degree is in an unrelated subject, you must demonstrate their interest in the programme through the supplementary questionnaire.

If your first language is not English, you must provide recent evidence that your spoken and written command of the English language is adequate for the programme. For more information see English language requirements for UCL and University of Kent.
