3. Resume / CV (in English) Formats: *.pdf	0 – 10 points Please submit a standard CV, including, at a minimum, your educational achievements, work and research experience, publications (if any), and language knowledge.
4. Letter of Motivation (in English) Formats: *.pdf	0-30 points This letter (1,5-3 pages) should describe your reasons for applying to this program, in the context of your long-term career goals and background.
5. Interview (in English) Interview is required for all applicants and can be arranged via videoconferencing.	 0-30 points Key criteria: erudition; spoken English; clarity of intent; interest in the topic; basic research and design skills.
