Portfolio contents and assessment criteria for applicants for the Master's programme in Supercomputer Simulations in Science and Engineering

Portfolio competition:

1) interview with the Admissions Committee - up to 60 points.

Interviews with international applicants, as well as those from other cities, can be held online.

2) individual achievements - up to 40 points.

Applicants shall submit their degree certificates (Bachelor's, Specialist, and/or Master's diplomas) with respective supplements in order to assess their individual achievements. Field-specific education, as well as diplomas with honours, shall be given particular consideration.

When the Committee reviews documents, the following research experience shall be considered:

- reports at international and Russian conferences, research seminars, etc., as confirmed by a certificate of participation issued to participants in such events, or the programme of an academic event
- publications or research papers (articles, key notes) accepted for publication. Web of Science, Scopus, VAC, and RSCI-indexed publications will be considered. Originals, or references to open sources, or a confirmation from the publisher must be submitted
- participation in research projects, and academic grants to be confirmed by the project's details and an abstract explaining the focus of the applicant's paper
- diplomas held by winners and prizewinners of international student competitions/olympiads (diplomas in the relevant field of study shall be considered)
- personal scholarships (as confirmed by a statement issued by a foundation or dean's office, or a list with winners of a scholarship competition from an open source).

When assessing individual achievements:

- 1) Total scores for individual achievements shall not exceed 40 points. The points shall be counted as per the Table of Individual Achievements. An applicant's achievements for the 4 (four) years before their admission shall be counted, unless otherwise specified in the Table;
- 2) Extra points for each individual achievement shall be granted only if relevant confirmations have been submitted:
- 3) Individual achievements, as specified in p. 4 and p. 6 hereof (Table of Individual Achievements), will be counted only once;
- 4) Reports presented at online-conferences shall not be viewed as individual achievements;
- 5) A conference shall be considered international if English is its working language. In all other cases, the conference shall be referred to p. 2 (Table of Individual Achievements);
- 6) With total points being equal, an applicant having at least 1 (one) individual achievement shall have priority for admission.
- 7) Up to 5 (five) points shall be granted for the total number of certificates and diplomas (p. 10 of the Table of Individual Achievements).

3	Publication in a research journal	15 points for Web of Science or Scopus-indexed journals, in Q1 or Q2; 10 points for Web of Science or Scopus-indexed journals, in Q3 or Q4; 5 points – for non-indexed journals, included in the VAC/RSCI list.
4	Winners and prizewinners of hackathons	4-10 points
4	One of the following certificates available: TOEFL, IELTS, FSE, CAE or CPE	4 points, provided that the result was obtained at least within two years before the application date
5	An application for a patent	2 points
6	A patent	4 points
7	Bachelor's, Specialist or Master's diploma	4-10 points (taking into account the field of study, average score, diplomas with honours, etc.)
8	Participation in research projects in a relevant field of study	10 points
9	Practical experience in a relevant field	10 points
10	Personal achievements (certificates, diplomas, scholarships, etc.)	0-5 points
