

Track 2 correlates with 3-rd year students' curriculum and covers both international and regional studies. There are also more specialized courses related to modern energy politics, digital economy, environmental economics and politics and other issues. The individual study plan should be combined from the disciplines mentioned below. It is also possible to adjust the individual curriculum regarding language proficiency as well as elective and major courses and include the options from the 1,2 or 4 years of study during the interview with the academic supervisor of the program.
