List of documents for passing the entrance test in the form of a competitive selection based on the application package of foreign applicants to the educational program «Mathematics»

1. Required Documents:
1.1. Application form and CV (the applicants fill out the application form online and attach the CV separately);
1.2. Letter of motivation;
1.3. Result of the Interview (Issued by the Selection Committee, this document is NOT provided by the applicant.)
1.4. Copy of applicant's degree certificate (diploma or academic transcripts);
1.5. Letters of recommendation (written by colleagues, lecturers, academic supervisors, experts in the applicant's field of study);
2. Other documents, certifying educational and scientific achievements of the applicant (see the list below in Table 2).

## Evaluation criteria for international applicants in «Mathematics»

The application package is scored out of a total of 50 points, distributed as indicated below. Applicants whose application package scores less than 31 points are considered unsuccessful and not invited to the interview. For the rest of applicants, the interview takes place online. The results of the interview are also scored out of a total of 50 points. The Applicants are ranked by the total of the application package score and the interview score.

| Letters of recommendation <br> (at least one is required) | Written recommendations from experts, <br> academic leaders, teachers, colleagues. <br> Both the content of the recommendation <br> and the scientific reputation of the <br> recommender are taken into account. | 10 |


| Online interview | Takes place if the initial application <br> package scores to 31 points or higher. | 50 |

Table 2: Achievements to be taken into consideration when evaluating the applicant's CV (provided that the corresponding supporting documents are included in the application package)
