Credentials for application portfolio for international applicants of the master program Financial Markets and Financial institutions at the Faculty of Economic Sciences of the Higher School of Economics, Moscow

- 1.1. application form (application submitted through the international applicants personal account);
- 1.2. a resume indicating the level of education and the name of the educational institution, its location, grades for courses in finance and economics, English language proficiency, achievements (awards, publications, participation in conferences, professional certificates, etc.)
- 1.3. a copy of a degree certificate confirming the level of education (diploma or transcript);
- 1.4. a document confirming the level of English language proficiency (certificates, completed courses);
- 1.5. Copies of certificates of completion of online courses (Coursera, National Platform of the Russian Federation) in any subject;
- 1.6. interview (only if recommended by program admission committee, not a required element of portfolio);
- 1.7. copies of documents confirming scientific publications, presentations at scientific seminars/conferences.

Criteria for portfolio assessment (maximum 100 points)

English proficiency assessment, by certificates and relevant grades during bachelors study	0 - 10	Those who score more than 60 points are offered a partial scholarship of 25% Those who score more than 75 points are offered a) a partial scholarship of 50% b) interview	

Diploma or transcript	0 - 15		Those who score more than 85 points including the interview, are offered full scholarship to study at the Financial Markets and Financial Institutions master program
