It should not exceed 6,000 characters.	15
Copy of the document confirming education (<i>copies of bachelor's or master's diploma(s) and diploma supplement</i>)	A diploma grade point average normalized to a 10-point scale is evaluated	10
Letters of recommendation (from employer and/or supervisor)	Should reflect the skills available to the applicant	10
